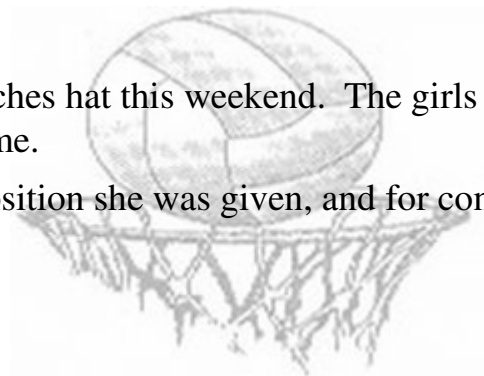
A huge thanks to Helen Steicke for stepping into the coaches hat this weekend. The girls worked together and did a great job, improving all the time.

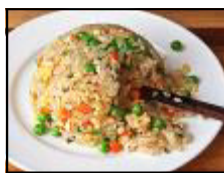
